# Protect Keiki at School:



Meals, Snacks, and Water Breaks should ALL BE DONE OUTDOORS

“Mask breaks” taken outdoors only with a minimum of 10 ft. distancing

Masks NEED to be WORN AT ALL times indoors

ONLY CONSIDER IN-PERSON SCHOOL WHEN POSITIVITY IS UNDER 1% OR CASES UNDER 2 PER 100,000 (DOH GUIDELINES)

# SAFER

Indoor mask breaks taken at teacher discretion  
Inconsistent enforcement of mask wearing

## Mask Policy

Masks worn indoors 100% of the time  
Breaks taken outdoors only with 10 ft.+ distance

Allows students to socialize outside their designated cohorts

## Break & Recess

Supervised, no-contact, outdoor activities & plan for inclement weather

Students eat indoors  
Long lines to get lunches increasing exposure time

## Meals, Snacks, & Water

Serve Grab & Go -  
Eat at home or outdoors in physically-distanced and assigned seating areas

Rotating students between classes  
Rotating teachers between classes

## Cohorts

Arrange schedules to keep students in the same group for all classes & activities  
Eliminate intermixing of students

Office staff & parents acting as health aides unlicensed health aide with off-campus supervisor

Students sent to a healthroom, but sent back to class after symptoms reported

Students & staff show up at school sick or with symptoms instead of staying home

## COVID Response Protocol & Management of Positive Cases

Licensed nurse(s) on every campus full-time (substitute nurses on call)  
Designated school and DOH point people for coordination of contact tracing  
System to maintain daily logs for each student and cohort to facilitate effective contact tracing  
Clearly marked isolation areas & rooms

Students switch classrooms or desks without sanitization between use  
High-touch surfaces indoor & outdoors ignored  
No regular sanitization & no accountability for bathroom cleaning  
Frequently used doors closed (this creates unnecessary high-touch surfaces)

## Cleaning

Desks and other high touch surfaces are sanitized between student use with approved disinfectant following product instructions  
Written cleaning procedures and regularly updated cleaning logs available for viewing  
Doors remain open

Closed windows and doors  
Small indoor spaces with recirculating air

## Ventilation

All indoor spaces pass air quality inspection conducted by an expert
